In the beginning...

The **Rockhampton HOG** Chapter was formed on the 28th of January 1995. In 1997, the Chapter introduced the current format of the Official Ride held on the 1st Sunday of the month and the Chapter Meeting held on the 3rd Saturday followed by a social night after the meeting. Often there is an imprompturide that Sunday.

The Chapter has hosted the QLD State Rally on two previous occasions. Firstly in 1998 and then again in 2009 with 100's of bikes from all over Australia and New Zealand heading to Rockhampton for the weekend. We also regularly attend events held by other Chapters. On the local scene, the Chapter gets involved in raising much needed funds for local charities throughout the year by holding or supporting Poker Runs, Toy Rides, Wild Woman Rides etc.

Since 1995, the *Rockhampton Harley Owners Group* membership has grown from just 18 at the 1st ever meeting to a peak of over 150 members. Currently we have around 128 active and financial members. It is not uncommon to have 30+ bikes on Official Rides.

In 2009, just prior to holding the State Rally, the *Rumble Inn* was built at the back of RHD. This is the venue for the monthly meetings and is also open every Friday evening from 5pm till 10pm for Chapter members and their guests to come and socialise at the end of the working week. So if you're interested in joining the Chapter or just passing through, drop in for a cold one with a great bunch of *Rockhampton HOG* members.





SENIOR FIRST AID COURSE

Please let Cathy (aka Nasty or Nurse Nasty) know if you would be interested in completing a Senior First Aid Course early in the New Year. Please give it some serious thought - first aid skills won't only be handy in the event of misfortune during a club ride or event, but also in your own homes. Below is an email from the Queensland Ambulance Service regarding the course they run:

"We can accommodate up to 20 people on a course depending on the training venue. It would be easier to conduct the course in our training room here as we have all the facilities and saves having to transport all the gear. An indicative price is \$134.50/person which is the current public price for Apply First Aid 1 day course. I assume you would require the course on a weekend so we would probably require 12-15 people to make it viable. We also have E-learning options where people undertake the theory component on an interactive DVD then just come for a 3 hour practical component."







MEDICAL CONDITIONS

If you have a medical condition which could effect you during a HOG Ride or Event, please give details to Cathy (aka Nasty or Nurse Nasty) so that relevant information can be added to the list carried by the Road Captain and in Mavis (in the First Aid Kit). This will help us help you in the event of a medical emergency or accident.

PATCH PLACEMENT ON VESTS

I contacted Kim Williams (HOG Executive) to see if there were any hard and fast rules regarding patch placement on vests. This is what she had to say:

3. only display the H.O.G eagle logo with Chapter's official name, which name must be displayed above the H.O.G eagle logo and within the official H.O.G. Chapter chevron as depicted below:



No we don't have a document about HOG pins/patch placement. I don't believe there would be an official one like this.

The only time we have determined how a rocker should be placed is in our Trademark agreement with Chapters and this paragraph below states the Chapter official name rocker should be positioned about the HOG eagle logo. Apart from that there are no set rules.



An email I received from Rockhampton HOG Member Dale Bowen (aka Bowie):

There was a bit of interest in my Fried Rice last night (dinner after the monthly meeting) so I thought I would put it in this month's newsletter as well as a recipe of a Zucchini Slice Debbie makes:

BOWIE'S FRIED RICE

Ingredients:

2 cups rice

3 cups water

2 tbs chicken stock powder

1/2 cup vegetable oil

1/2 tsp sesame oil

4 eggs

4 bacon rashers

1 large onion

1-2 sticks celery

1/2 green capsicum

2 shallots

1 cup frozen peas

1 small tin corn kernels

1 tin prawns

Left over chicken or ham

1 Tablespoon of Soy Sauce (optional)!!!

Method:

Pre-heat oven to 200 degrees (fan forced).

Mix rice, water, chicken stock powder, vegetable oil and sesame oil all together in baking dish, cover with alfoil and place in oven for 35 minutes.

Cook 4 beaten eggs in frying pan until set. Remove and chop up.

Dice bacon rashers and onion and cook in pan until lightly brown.

Chop up 1 to 2 sticks celery, half a green capsicum and 2 or more shallots.

Remove rice from oven when cooked. Add frozen peas, corn kernels, bacon, onion, eggs, celery, capsicum, shallots and prawns to the rice. Add left over chicken or ham.

DEBBIE'S ZUCCHINI SLICE

Ingredients:

375g of Zucchini (3 nice size ones)

3 nice size Carrots

3 Bacon Rashers and 1 large Onion all (finely chopped)

1 Cup of Grated Cheddar Cheese

1 Cup of Self-Raising Flour

5 Eggs (lightly beaten)

Half Cup of Vegetable Oil

Salt and Pepper

Method:

Pre-heat oven to 180 degrees (fan forced).

Grate unpeeled zucchinis and carrots and place in bowl with the bacon, onion, cheese, eggs, oil, salt, pepper and sifted flour. Mix with wooden Spoon.

Pour into a well-greased lamington tin or baking dish and bake for 30 to 40 minutes or until browned.


- 1. June 15: He took 24 boxes of condoms and randomly put them in other people's carts when they weren't looking.

New Member Information



The following is information for new Members about the Rockhampton HOG Chapter:

Monthly Meetings - As a Member of the Rockhampton HOG Chapter, you are encouraged to attend our Chapter meetings held on the third Saturday of each month. They are a great time to socialise and get together with old and new friends. We discuss Chapter business and convey information about up and coming events and activities. These meetings start at 0530pm at the back of Rocky Harley-Davidson (RHD) aka The Rumble Inn. There is usually an impromptu ride the day after the meeting (Sunday) with the nature and destination decided upon either at the meeting or on the Sunday morning just prior to departure from RHD (which is normally around 0900am).

Monthly Rides - As a Member of the Rockhampton HOG Chapter, you are encouraged to attend the monthly ride on the first Sunday of each month. They nearly always depart from the back of Rocky Harley-Davidson (RHD) aka The Rumble Inn at a pre-arranged time. They vary in length, nature and destination and are always a lot of fun. For those with partners and/or families who don't ride and/or prefer not to be a pillion, the Chapter has its own 11 seater bus (Mavis) which follows on all rides and is available to Members and their families. It is asked that those who use the bus make a reasonable monetary contribution towards fueling Mavis after returning from the ride.

The Rumble Inn - in 2009, just prior to the Rockhampton HOG Chapter holding the Queensland State Rally, the Rumble Inn was built at the back of RHD. This is the venue for the monthly meetings and is the starting point for most of our monthly rides. It is also open every Friday evening from 5pm to 10pm for Chapter Members and their guests to come and socialise at the end of the working week. Mavis (the Chapter bus) has a designated driver every Friday night and is available to take you home if required. It is asked that you pay a "fare" into Mavis's Money Tin (mounted in the bus) when you arrive at your destination to help fuel her up for next time.

Rockhampton HOG Chapter Website - is located at www.rockyhog.com. To access the Members Only section, you need to be a current Member of the Rockhampton HOG Chapter. Once you are, ask Carolyn at RHD for the password to sign up to the website. On the site you will find some Chapter history, ride rules, past newsletters, photos, classifieds, upcoming events and lots more. It also has a Forum where you can introduce yourself etc.

Rockhampton HOG Newsletter - Our newsletter is issued monthly and includes our ride calendar and other information for Members plus stories about what has happened in the Chapter during the previous month. Our newsletter only works if you contribute too so please don't forget to send in recollections of previous rides, photos and any other bits and pieces you think other Members may be interested in. Photos of the rides are always popular! Contributions can be emailed to editor@rockyhog.com. The newsletter is published on the Chapter website www.rockyhog.com. Each month's issue is normally uploaded no later than the Sunday after the monthly meeting. A limited number of printed copies are also available from the Rumble Inn (first in best dressed).



GUIDELINES FOR SAFE RIDING ON HOG RIDES

- There will be a briefing before all rides so arrive at the designated start point half an hour before departure time.
- Pay attention to the ride briefing given by the Road Captain. If in doubt Ask.
- If you are experiencing any difficulty that might affect others, let the Road Captain know before departure.
- Always fuel up before the start of the ride.
- Make sure your bike is in roadworthy condition. Check this before you leave home, not 5 minutes before
 the ride time. Check all lights, battery, tyres, etc.
- As a general rule, the group will depart and arrive as a group.
- Unless arranged prior to departure, do not pass the Road Captain.
- Use only one lane of a multilane highway. Follow the lead of the Road Captain as to which lane to use.
- Ride in a staggered formation except on narrow roads where you should follow in Indian or single file.
 When a rider leaves the group (eg. turning off to go home), or changes position in the formation, the remaining group will switch lanes using indicators to signal intention, and restore the staggered formation.

Staggered Formation Riding

Below is the primary riding formation.

Single file is used when directed by the ride leader.


One-second rule: The bike in the lane to your left or right should not be less than one second ahead of you.

Two-second rule: Maintain at least two seconds between you and the rider in front of you.

Four-second rule: Look ahead four seconds at your immediate path of travel to give yourself more time to react to a hazard.


Twelve-second rule: Also look ahead at your anticipated path of travel.

Twelve seconds is about one city block.



- When overtaking, maintain your overtaking speed until those overtaking with you have enough room to pull in behind without having to break suddenly.
 - If you intend to travel at a slower pace than expected on the ride, position yourself towards the rear of the group and not in the front or the middle.
 - New riders should take up position in front of "Tail End Charlie" for the first few rides. This is at the rear of the Pack.
 - Keep an eye on the rider behind you. If they stop unexpectedly, you stop and determine the problem before proceeding. The rider behind you is your responsibility. An exception to this rule is "Tail End Charlie" - there should be no one behind him/her.

Most importantly - "RIDE SAFE AND HAVE FUN"




